Key Accountabilities

3. Prepare pupils for a wide range of Art and DT scholarships.
4. Support colleagues with creating effective lesson plans, medium and long-term planning and sourcing resources.
5. Maintaining accurate and detailed records of pupil progress and attainment and reporting on same.
6. Completing reports and references on individuals or groups as required
7. Fully responsible for the pastoral welfare of pupils under care, both at school and when offsite; Contribute to the extra-curricular activities and be fully involved in the wider aspects of our school.
