Purpose

To teach Mathematics across the 11-16 age group and support the personal development of children within their tutor group.

Key Accountabilities

- Provide excellent, inspirational and dedicated teaching in a safe and stimulating environment
- Teach Mathematics to pupils in KS3 (Years 7-9) and KS4 (Years 10-11)
- Take responsibility for promoting, coordinating and participating in Mathematics activities throughout the school year via after-school clubs, enrichment activities, guest-speakers, themed weeks and House competitions
- Plan lessons and schemes of work both independently and collaboratively with the Mathematics Department that address the various needs of both our individual pupils and the wider cohort
- Contribute to the creation of departmental development plans, policies, curriculum documents, risk assessments etc. in liaison with the Mathematics Department and the Senior Leadership Team
- Record and report upon the development, progress and attainment of all pupils and share this information with pupils, parents/guardians and colleagues
- Communicate with parents/guardians in a timely, transparent and positive manner
- Deploy the data from assessment to ensure that individual pupils have targets that challenge and stretch their ability
